Our goal is to create a safe, fun, and positive environment for every camper. Everyone at camp—players, coaches, and families—has a role in making this happen. Please review this with your camper(s) before participating.

For Players:

- Be respectful and kind to coaches, teammates, and other campers.
- Listen and follow coaches instructions.
- Stay focused during drills, games, and activities.
- Give your best effort, even when learning something new.
- Ask for help when needed and support teammates who are struggling.
- Use positive language—no cursing, shaming or put-downs.
- Play safely—no intentional injury, roughhousing, or dangerous behavior.
- Respect others' property and camp equipment.

Consequences:

Camp staff—including coaches, team leaders, and camp directors—will work with any camper who violates the rules to resolve issues and help them get back on track. If a camper continues to break the rules or behaves in a way that is unsafe or disruptive, they may be asked **not to return for the remainder of camp or future sessions**. Families will be notified if this occurs. No refunds will be issued for removal from camp.

- Coaches and camp staff will help you fix problems first.
- If the rules keep being broken or someone is unsafe, you may be asked **not to come back for the rest of camp.**
